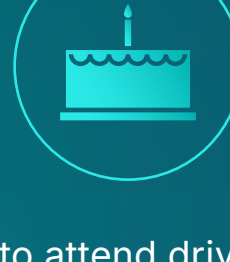

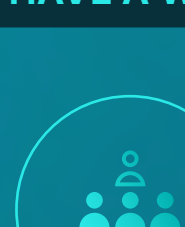


I PLAN TO ENROLL IN DRIVER'S ED

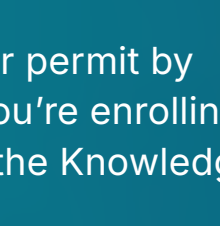


Congratulations! All you have to do now to get your permit is enroll in driver's ed at OnTarget and send us an email with your WDL# so we can submit a waiver to the DOL.

I AM BETWEEN 15 1/2 AND 16 YEARS OLD



Life is about to get really fun for you! Let's walk through your next steps by answering some questions:

Do you need a permit?

YES



Getting your driver's permit in Washington has quite a few qualifications that many find confusing. The following questions will help you know exactly what you need to do in your specific situation.

Are you enrolled/enrolling in driver's ed?

YES



Lucky you! You can get your permit without first taking the dreaded Knowledge (written) Test because you're enrolled/enrolling in driver's ed!

How?

If you don't plan to enroll in driver's ed for your permit you must meet the following qualifications first:

1. Be age 15 1/2 or older
2. Get a WDL# (if you don't already have state ID with a WDL# on it):

3. Sign up for a WA State License Express account (you'll need to log into License Express to take the test, please arrive with your credentials, plus other identifying info they may need):

4. Take your Knowledge Test and pass it with 80% or higher. Visit our testing availability:

1. Be 16+ years of age
2. Have held permit for 6 months
3. Logged 50 hours of driving practice with a qualified licensed driver (10 hours at night)
4. Passed the Skills Test with 80%+

DID YOU KNOW YOU CAN TAKE YOUR SKILLS TEST BEFORE YOUR 16TH BIRTHDAY?



You can take your Skills Test before you turn 16 if you meet the following qualifications:

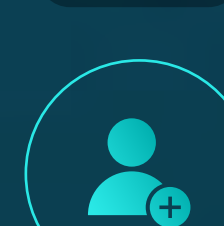
1. You're over 15 1/2 years old
2. You've completed driver's ed
3. You've logged 50 hours of driving practice with a qualified licensed driver (10 hours at night)
4. You've had your permit for 6 months
5. You've passed your Knowledge Test

By testing ahead of time, you get it out of the way and can get your license from the DOL as soon as your 16th birthday!

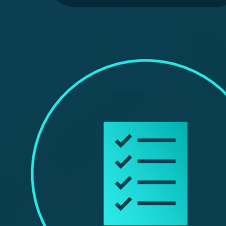

Washington State requires driver's license applicants to meet the following qualifications to get licensed before 18:

1. Complete an approved driver's ed course
2. Be at least 16 years of age
3. Have held a driver's permit for 6 months
4. Log 50 hours of driving practice with a qualified licensed driver (10 hours at night)
5. Pass the Knowledge Test with a score of 80% or higher
6. Pass the Skills Test with a score of 80% or higher

I AM OVER 18 YEARS OLD



Being a little bit older and getting your driving license isn't a bad way to go. With age comes more wisdom after all.

As an 18+ year old, the DOL requires the following for you to qualify for your driving license:

1. Pass the Knowledge Test with 80% or higher. You probably already did this to get your permit, but your test is only valid for 2 years.
2. Pass the Skills (driving) Test with a score of 80% or higher.
